Christendom College Financial Aid Estimator:

This form is used to prepare an estimate of financial aid for which you may be eligible. Our estimate is based on a uniform mathematical and economic formula of need analysis. You must still submit the Christendom *2010-11 Financial Aid Application* and all required tax forms and supporting schedules to be eligible for need-based funds. The *Application* should be submitted no later than April 1, 2010, but not before January 1, 2010.

The early Financial Aid Estimator that we provide is only an estimate of your financial assistance and should serve only as a planning guide for 2010-2011. You will receive an official financial award after you have been accepted to Christendom College and have completed a Christendom *Financial Aid Application*.

General Instructions:

Please do not leave any field blank. If a question does not pertain to you, indicate with N/A (not applicable) or a zero. Remember that the information you are providing is based on an estimate of your 2009 income, but you may refer to your 2008 income tax forms when completing this estimator.

The following explanations may be helpful when completing this form:

Section 2: Household Information

9. *Marital Status of Parents*: If your parents are divorced and your custodial parent is remarried, the parent status should indicate Married. The questions pertain to only your custodial parent(s). Do not include information on a parent or stepparent with whom you do not reside.

10. *Family Size*: The number in the family, including the student.

11. *Number in College*: The number in college should include only those family members who will be enrolled full time in an accredited institution during 2010-2011.

Section 3: Income

14. *Adjusted Gross Income*: Your total income minus any adjustments.

15. *Estimated Income Tax Paid*: This includes income tax paid. It is not the amount of tax withheld on your W-2, but the actual federal income tax paid. Make sure this amount does not include any FICA tax paid.

16. *Father's and/or Mother's Income from Work*: Include the "wages, salaries, tips, etc.," from the IRS Tax Forms.

17. *Untaxed Income*: This is untaxed income and benefits, such as Social Security benefits, AFDC, child support received, welfare, pensions, military subsistence allowances, and veterans benefits.

Section 4: Asset Information

19. *Cash and Savings*: This includes cash and the current balance in your savings and checking accounts.

20. *Real Estate and Investments Value*: This does not include your family's principal residence. Include rental property, land, and second or summer homes. Investments include trust funds, money market funds, mutual funds, certificates of deposit, stocks, bonds, other securities, installment and land sale contracts, etc. Do not include the value of life insurance and retirement plans (pension funds, annuity, IRA and Keogh plans).

21. *Debt Against Real Estate and Investments*: The amount you owe on real estate (excluding your principal residence) and investments.

22. *Business or Farm Value*: The amount that your business or farm is worth today. Include the market value of land, buildings, machinery, equipment, inventories, livestock, etc. Do not include a family farm if it is your principal residence.

23. *Debt Against Business*: The amount that is owed on the business or farm. Include only the present mortgage and related debts for which the business and/or farm was used as collateral.

Section 5: Academic Profile

Grade point average (GPA): Your overall GPA is calculated from all classes attempted. The Core Academic GPA does not include non-academic courses.
