## ***TO APPLY FOR ADMISSION***

1. Complete the Application, either in paper format or on Christendom's internet site.
2. Write three essays on the topics below. The essays will be judged on content, grammar, spelling, and style. **Please proofread your work.**
  - a) Why do you want to attend Christendom College? (Please include what you hope to gain from your experience at Christendom; what you hope to add to the College's vibrant community; and what attracts you to the College.)  
**500 word minimum**
  - b) Describe your life within your family. (For example: do you have brothers and sisters? What interests do you share with the other members of your family?) Have you discussed your plans for college with your family? If so, what do they think?  
**250 word minimum**
  - c) Describe a person or experience who/which has had a deep impact on your life. Explain its value to you.  
**250 word minimum**
3. Enclose an application fee of \$25.00 payable to Christendom College (application fee is waived for online applications).
4. Send two letters of recommendation, one testifying to your academic competence (written by teacher, homeschooling parent, or academic counselor) and the other testifying to your character (written by a priest, club/group leader, family friend).
5. Send an official copy of the high school transcript to the Director of Admissions (a homeschool transcript may be found on Christendom's website).
6. Request that your SAT or ACT scores be sent to the Director of Admissions. If forms are not available at your high school, you can request that your scores be sent to us by visiting [www.collegeboard.com](http://www.collegeboard.com) for the SAT or [www.act.org](http://www.act.org) for the ACT. The examination code numbers for Christendom College are 5691 for the SAT, and 4339 for the ACT.

## ***EARLY ACTION OPTION***

The Early Action Option allows the candidate to apply for admission based on six semesters of high school work; however, seventh semester grades should be submitted if available. Complete Early Action applications must be received by December 1. Notification of Admissions Committee decision is sent by December 15. Notification of financial aid and/or academic scholarship is sent February 1 if filed tax information is available and if all financial aid documents have been completed.
