Checklist:

1. You must FIRST submit a Financial Aid application (visit: <https://www.christendom.edu/admissions/financial-aid/financial-aid-forms/>)
2. You must wait for a response from Christendom's Financial Aid office.
 - a. If you qualify for aid, you will receive an award letter via email
 - b. If you do not qualify for need-based aid, you will receive an email stating this fact.
 - c. If you qualify for academic scholarship, you will be notified upon acceptance. This merit-award will be included on your financial aid award.
3. Choose **ONE** 4-year Catholic college for Christendom to match.
 - a. Once you have chosen that one college, and submitted the PMP application, you cannot ask for a revised matching offer due to having received additional funds from your one college later on in the year.
4. You must submit the following items from the college to be matched:
 - a. The "Cost of Attendance" letter/notification which details:
 - i. the cost to attend that college (tuition, room, board, fees)
 - ii. the amount of scholarship you have received
 - iii. the amount of need-based aid you have received
 - iv. the amount of loans you are qualified to receive
 - v. the balance due (the amount of cash you owe)
5. You must complete the PMP Application.
6. *All Matching Offers will be decided by a special committee, with VP for Enrollment Tom McFadden serving as the main point of contact. **Please reserve your communications about this for him: tmcfadden@christendom.edu.***

PLEASE NOTE:

- Restrictions may apply.
- The college reserves the right to match or not match any particular offer presented, based on its current financial or enrollment needs. **In many cases, an offer will not be matched 100%. It is not guaranteed.**
- All applicants must first submit Christendom College's financial aid application and financial aid packets from the **one** school to be matched. A match cannot be made unless all of these items have been submitted.
- Any PMP award granted in combination with all other aid offered by the college will not exceed 100% of the cost of tuition.
- This offer is only available to new students who will be living on Christendom's campus during their 4 years, beginning Fall 2021. Other requirements:
 - Students must submit Christendom College's Financial Aid Application, requesting financial assistance (even if they did not complete the FAFSA for another college).
 - Submit a complete PMP Application. *Please note, only one PMP application per student may be submitted.*
 - Submit the financial aid letter showing how much you will have to pay at that same college or university.
 - The PMP committee may make exceptions and allow applicants to submit information from select public or private non-Catholic schools on a case-by-case basis.
 - All books, room/board, fees, travel, and personal expenses must be paid in full by students/families and the college will not apply the PMP to work-study credit given to student.
 - Students who qualify for Matching Funds will be required to maintain a GPA of at least a 2.0 during their time at Christendom.
