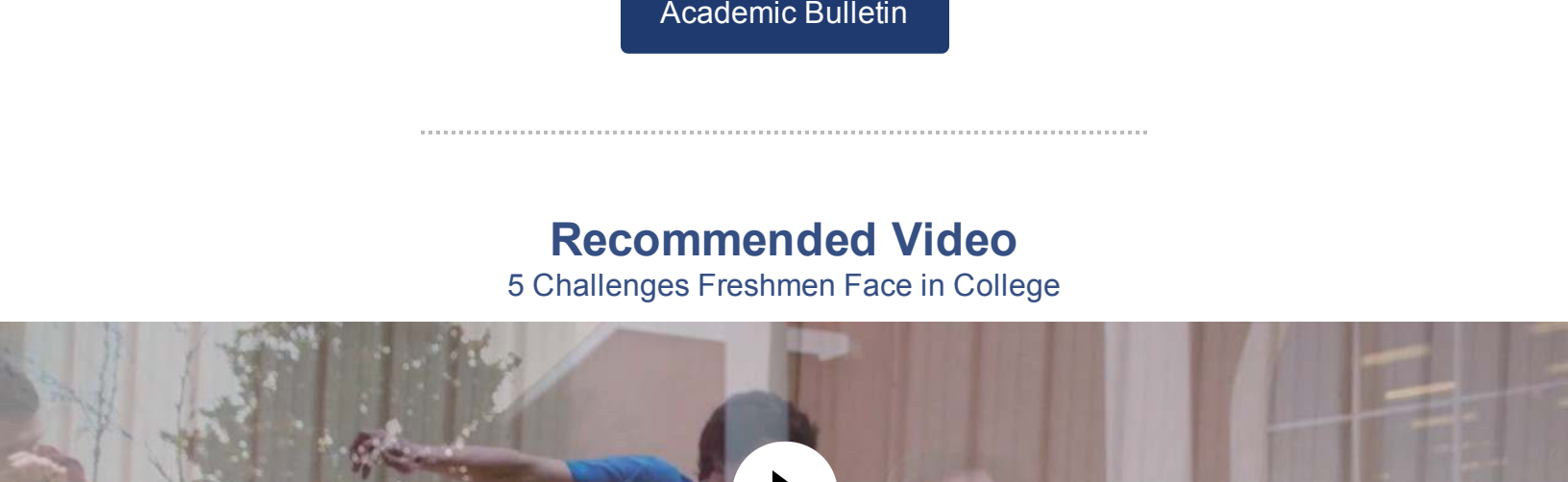
- July 10** - Deadline for Required Forms (see MyChristendom account to complete)
